CHILDCARE AND PRESCHOOL

Infant to 5 years

\$299/week

Application Fees: To reserve your spot, a non-refundable application fee of \$150 per child is required.

SCHOOL AGE CARE

FULL-TIME

Option 1

\$118/week

Includes before and after school care in addition to all planned no-school days.

Option 2*

\$96/week

Includes before and after school care only.

PART-TIME

Part-Time*

\$78/week

Only available for children in 4th or 5th grade. Includes before and after school care on 3 pre-selected days each week.

No-School Days

\$66/day

*If availability allows, those enrolled in Full-Time Option 2 or Part-Time may sign up for a no-school day, but will be charged for that day in addition to the regular weekly rates.

Application Fees: To reserve your spot, a non-refundable application fee of \$65 per child is required.

ENROLLMENT OPTIONS TO SERVE YOUR FAMILY BEST

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CHILDCARE ASSISTANCE (CCA)

- Child Care Assistance is a federal subsidy program administered by the Department of Social Services that helps with childcare tuition costs.
- Their subsidy **may cover up to 100% of your tuition cost!**
- Not all providers accept Child Care Assistance. Not only does EmBe accept it, but we also have team members dedicated to aiding you through the application process and the program.
- Since you cannot apply for CCA until 30 days prior to the child's start date in our program, please reach out to Sadie Mudder on our team via the contact information below to discuss potential eligibility. You can still enroll at EmBe today.
- **We highly encourage you to apply!** If it's your family's first time applying, or you are unsure if you qualify, reach out to Sadie Mudder on our team via the contact information below.

EMBE SCHOLARSHIP

- Our EmBe Education Scholarship Fund is available to those in the middle-middle, who do not qualify for Child Care Assistance but are still in need of financial assistance.
- **Our Scholarship Fund can help cover up to 20% of your tuition cost.**
- EmBe also offers scholarships to help cover application fees to enroll at an EmBe location.

SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCE

- Our Special Circumstance Scholarship is typically a temporary scholarship designed to assist an EmBe family for a period of time to help with extenuating circumstances. Sometimes that is to help during medical crises, loss of job, or other factors. Reach out to Sadie Mudder on our team, and she can assist you!

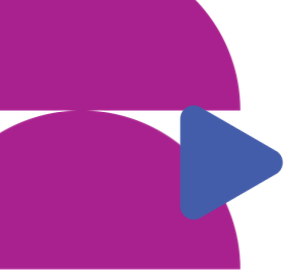
OTHER EMBE OPPORTUNITIES

- **Come work with EmBe and receive a tuition discount!** Full-Time Employees (30 hours+/week) receive a 65% discount. Part-time employees (10 hours+/week) receive a 30% discount. This can be used in tandem with CCA. To apply, go to embe.org/careers!



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SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

Do I Qualify?

How to Read the Scholarship Eligibility Chart

This chart helps families determine whether they qualify for EmBe's scholarship and, if so, which scholarship tier they may be eligible to receive.

Step 1: Find your family size.

Locate the row that matches your family size. Family sizes shown range from 2 to 8 family members.

Step 2: Determine your annual gross income.

Use your household's annual gross income (income before taxes and deductions) and compare it to the income ranges listed for your family size.

Step 3: Identify your scholarship tier.

- **Tier 1** is for families with the highest level of financial need. If your annual gross income is below the Tier 1 income limit for your family size, you qualify for Tier 1 assistance.
- **Tier 2** is for families whose income is above the Tier 1 limit but falls within the Tier 2 income range for their family size.

Step 4: Review the tuition discount.

- Families qualifying for **Tier 1** receive a **20% discount**, resulting in a weekly tuition rate of **\$239.20**.
- Families qualifying for **Tier 2** receive a **10% discount**, resulting in a weekly tuition rate of **\$269.10**.
